



CONFINED SPACE AWARENESS

Aim and Objective

The purpose of the training course is to prevent confined space injuries and to identify potential workplace tasks that need improvement. Also, to familiarise delegates from an Estates and Facilities background with the importance of planning any work in confined spaces prior to entry, how emergencies arise and the importance of following emergency arrangements.

Course Duration
