



SAFE SYSTEMS OF WORK – PERMIT TO WORK

Aim

This course is aimed at those working in the Estates and Facilities function of their organisation. The primary aims are to:

- Have a clear understanding of the main principles of any safe system of work
- Understand the purpose of Method Statement and Job Safety Analysis
- Understand the paperwork involved in the client's permit to work system
- Demonstrate a greater awareness of their responsibilities when involved with any permit system
- Understand the roles and responsibilities of those involved within the permit to work system

Course Duration

The course will be of half day duration and tailored to include client's internal procedures and documentation for inclusion within the presentation (prior discussion will be required before commencement of training)
