

WORKING AT HEIGHT TRAINING

Aim

This course is for those working within the Estates and Facilities function of their organisation.

Falls from height are one of the biggest causes of workplace fatalities and major injuries. Therefore, legal requirements for planning work at height including Duty holders responsibilities will be discussed.

At the end of the course delegates will have:

- An understanding of what is working at height?
- A better understanding of the Work at Height Regulations 2005
- Understand the duties of the employer and employee under these regulations
- Apply the conditions to their future work activities when working.

Course Duration

The course will be of half day duration and tailored to include client's internal procedures and documentation for inclusion within the presentation, prior discussion will be required prior to commencement of training.
